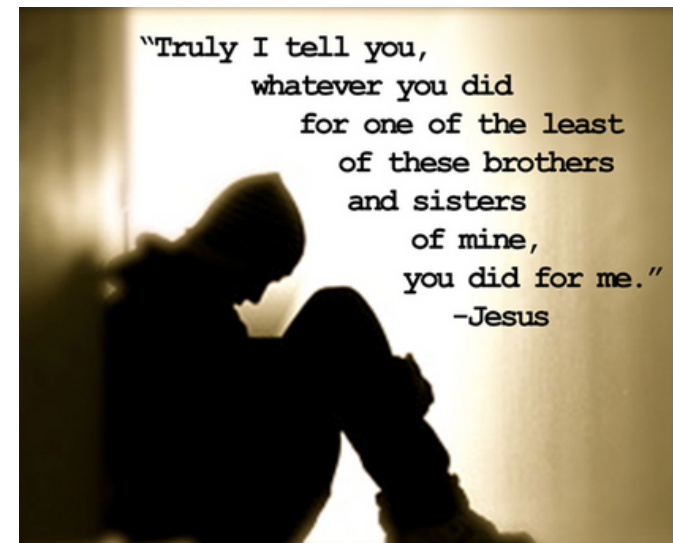


Solidarity

The common good means that the fruits of the earth belong to everyone. BTHCC is for everyone. Jesus teaches us that we are not the masters or owners.

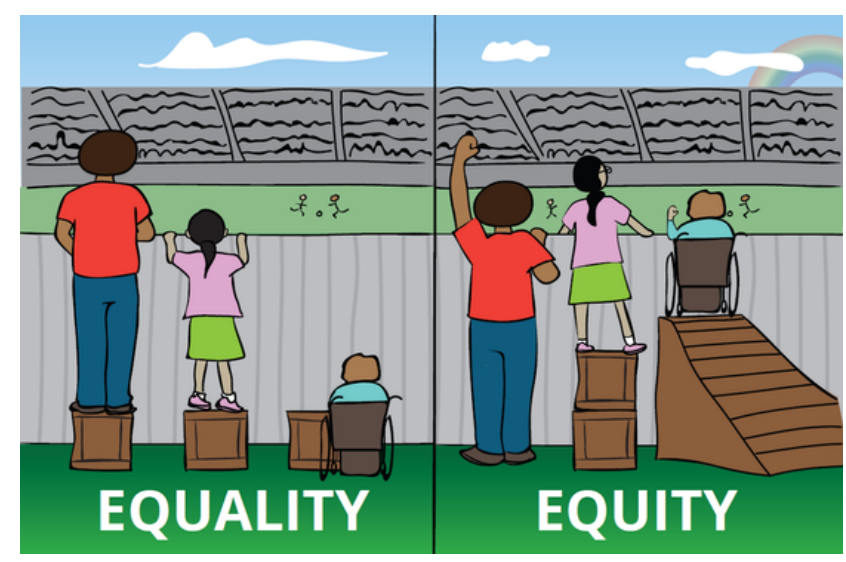
How do we listen to all voices to ensure we strive for the Common Good? Do we have opportunities for staff, parent and student voice in our department handbooks?

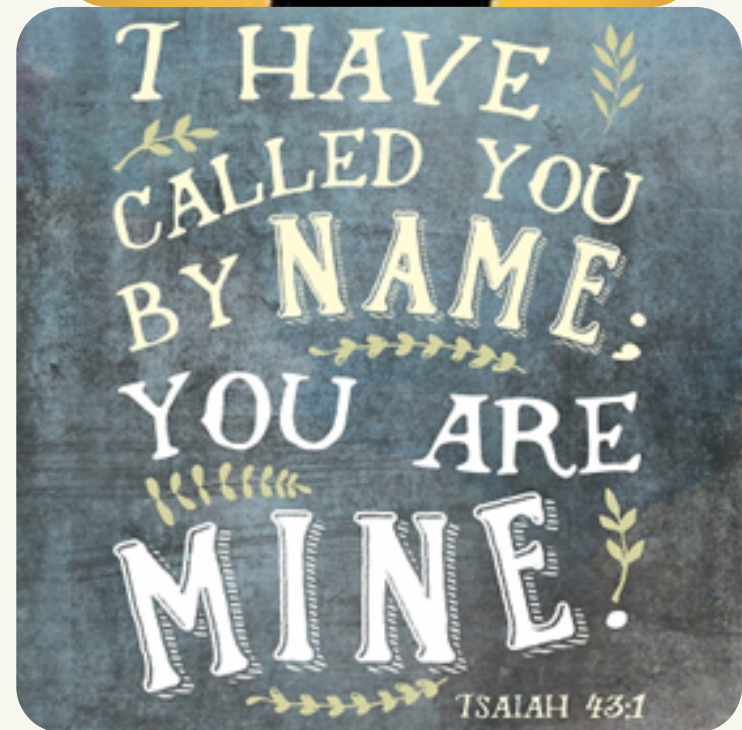
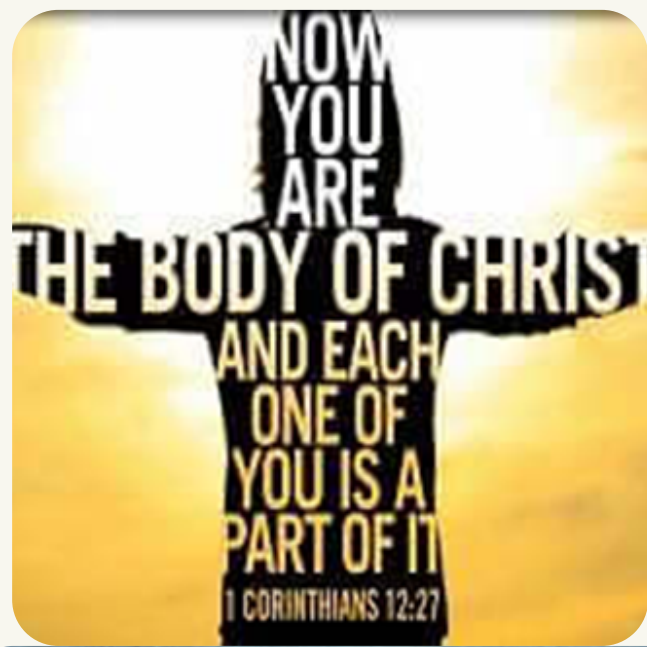


Creation and Environment
